

Pest Control

We appreciate having to deal with pests can be an anxious and stressful time.

Common pests found within homes are:

- Rodents
- Moths
- Ants
- Beetles
- Cockroaches
- Bedbugs

Tenants can contact our maintenance team to report pest within their homes.

To discourage pests follow these simple steps below:

- Make sure any waste bins are securely covered and emptied regularly.
- Keep your garden free of waste and rubbish
- If you have any waste that cannot fit in your bin, you can take this to one of Glasgow City Council's Household Waste Recycling Centres free of charge.
- Report any fly tipping to Glasgow City Council.
- Do not feed wildlife or birds in communal spaces or your own back garden space.
- Make sure your home is clutter free and tidy.
- Keep all kitchen and food preparation areas clear and store food in sealed containers.
- Report any minor water leaks promptly to deny water sources.
- If you move home or return from holiday, always check your belongings carefully to make sure you are not bringing any unwanted visitors with you.

Mice and Rats

During the recent weeks we have had a significant number of reports regarding mice and rats in resident gardens and in the streets within our area, if you come across evidence of rodents you should contact Glasgow City Council's Environmental Health. GCC will investigate and treat issues with mice or rats when the pests occur indoor or outdoor and this service is provided free of charge, they will liaise with LPHA to resolve issues such as filling access holes.
